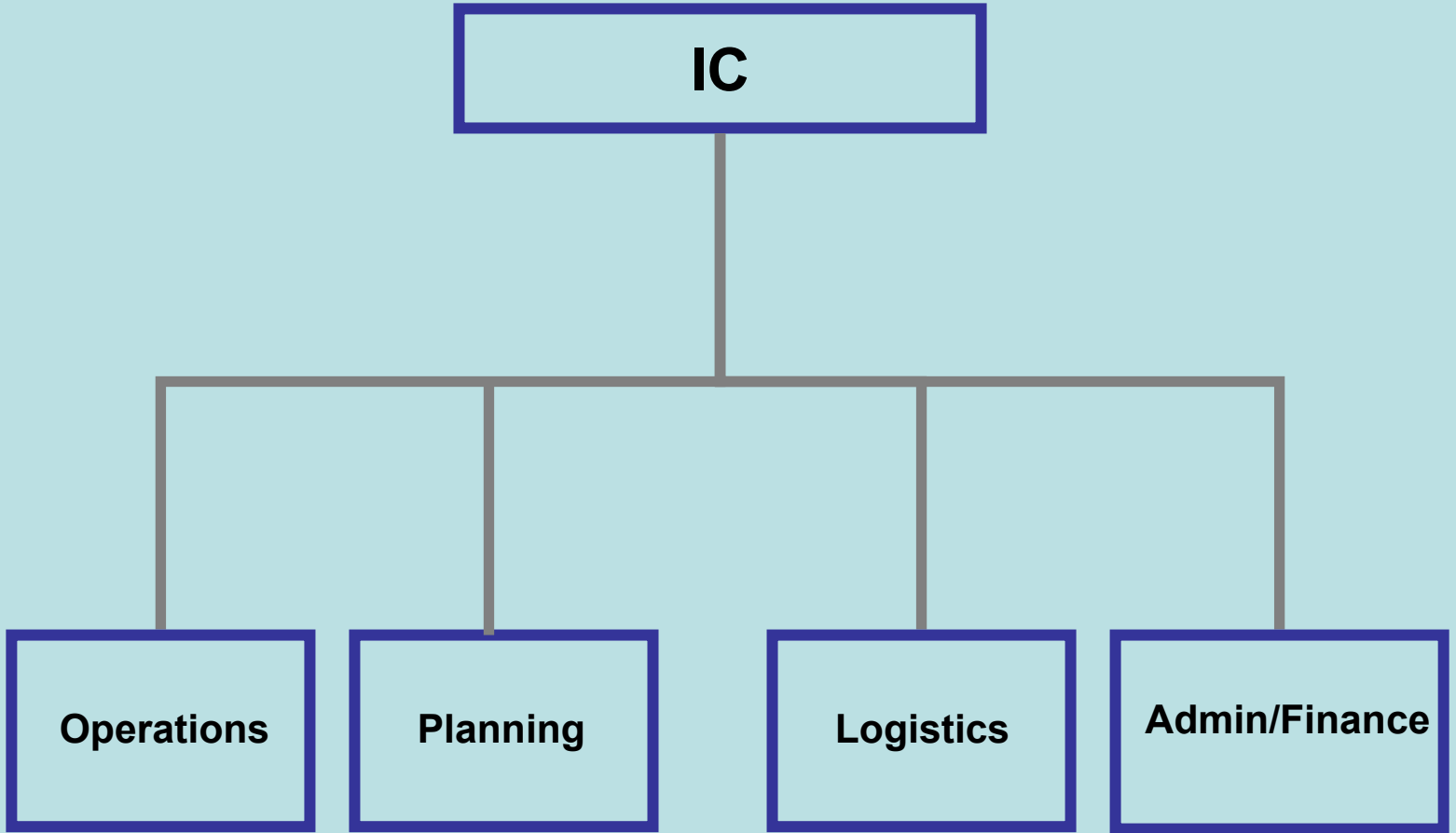


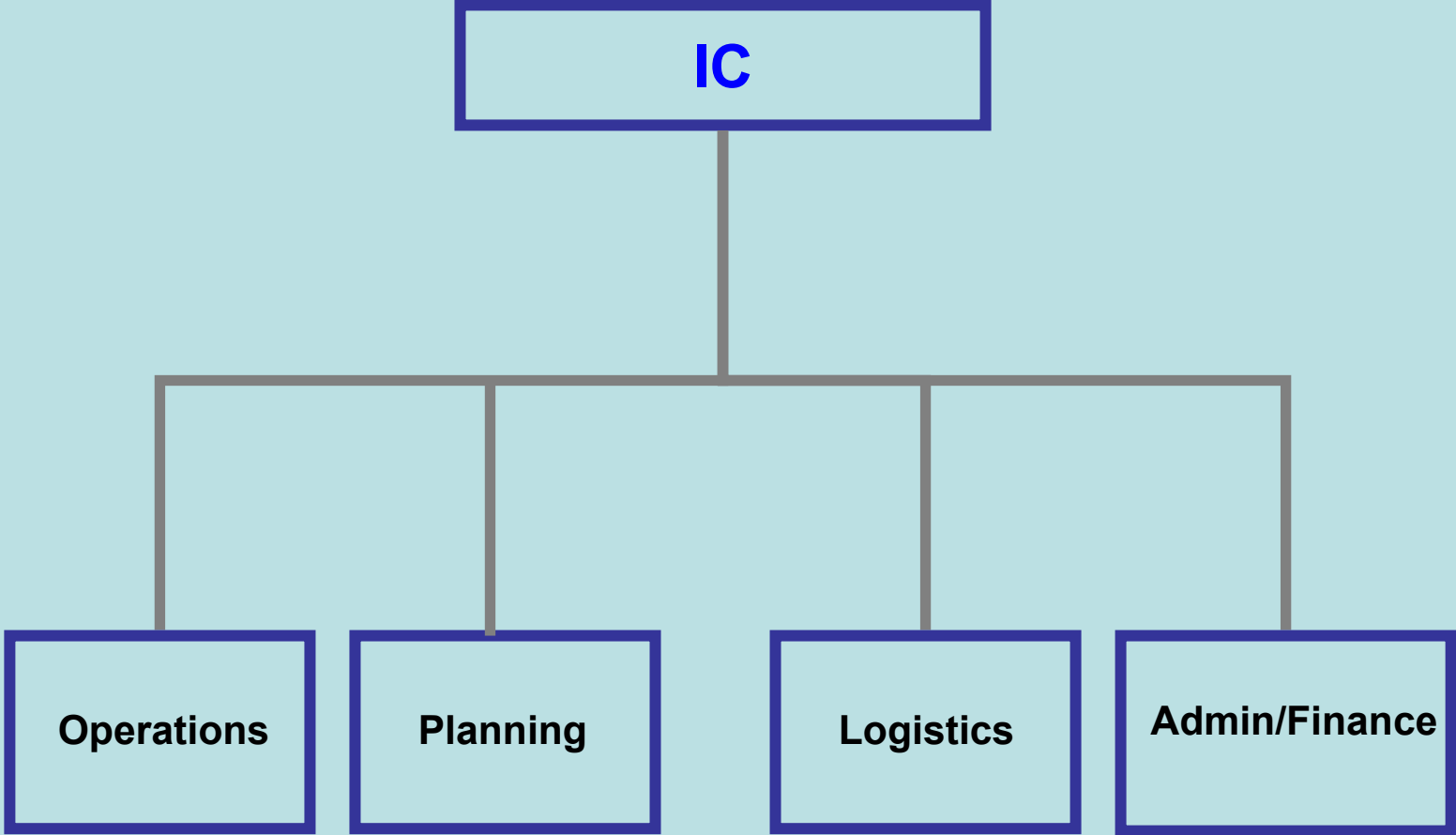

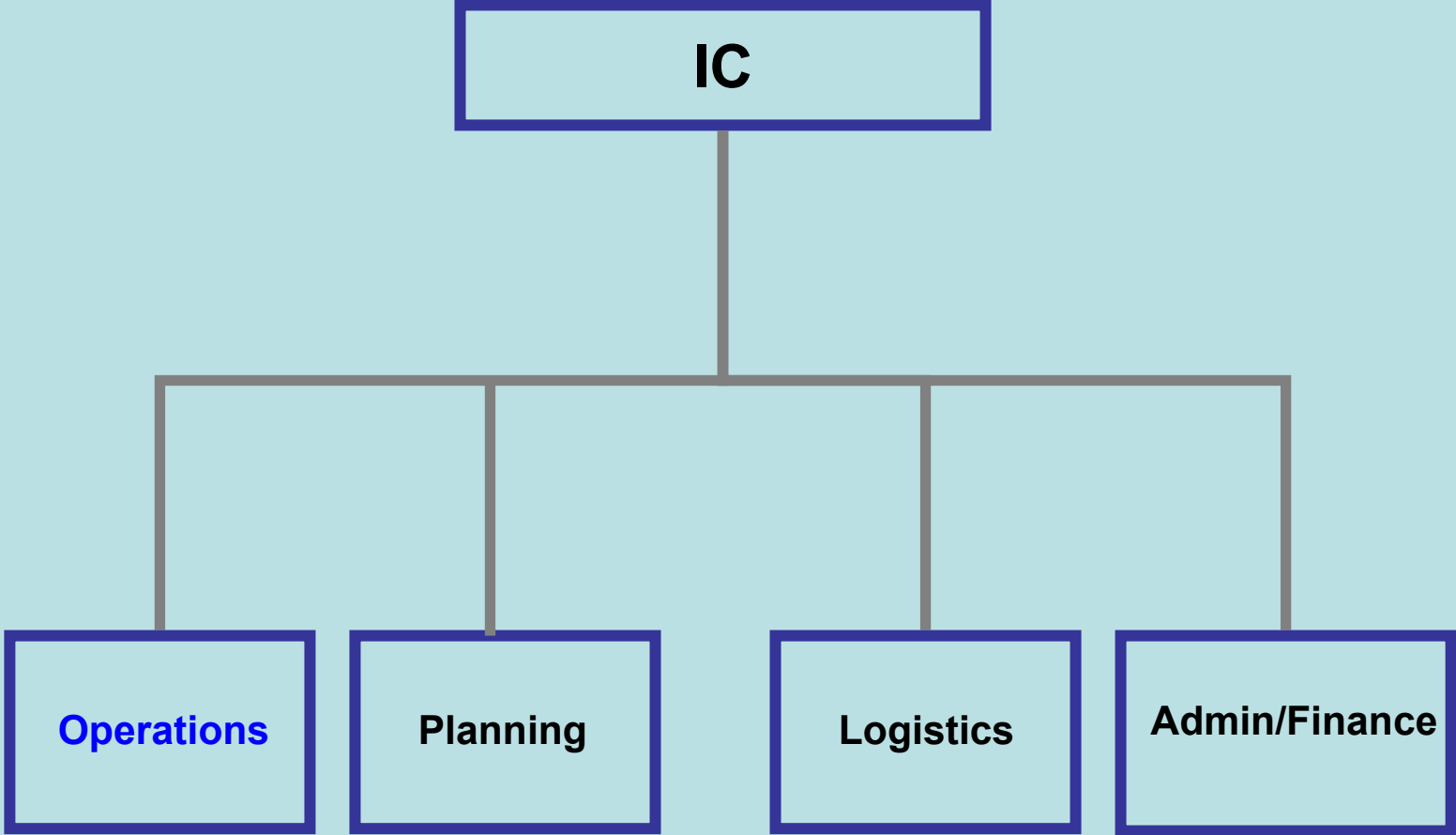
- Increased safety

- Open door to federal assistance (NIMS)

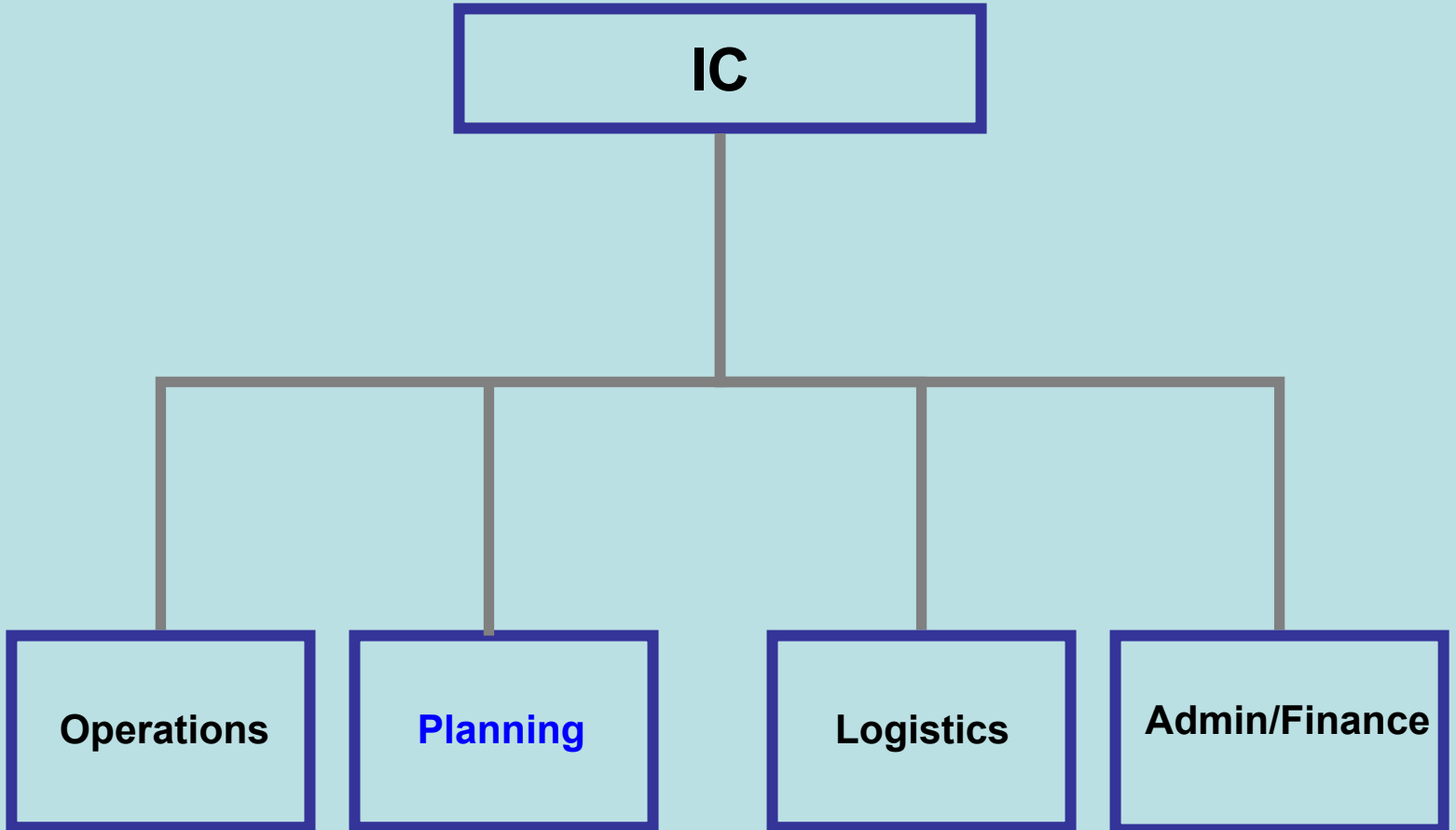
- Common terminology

- Modular and scalable









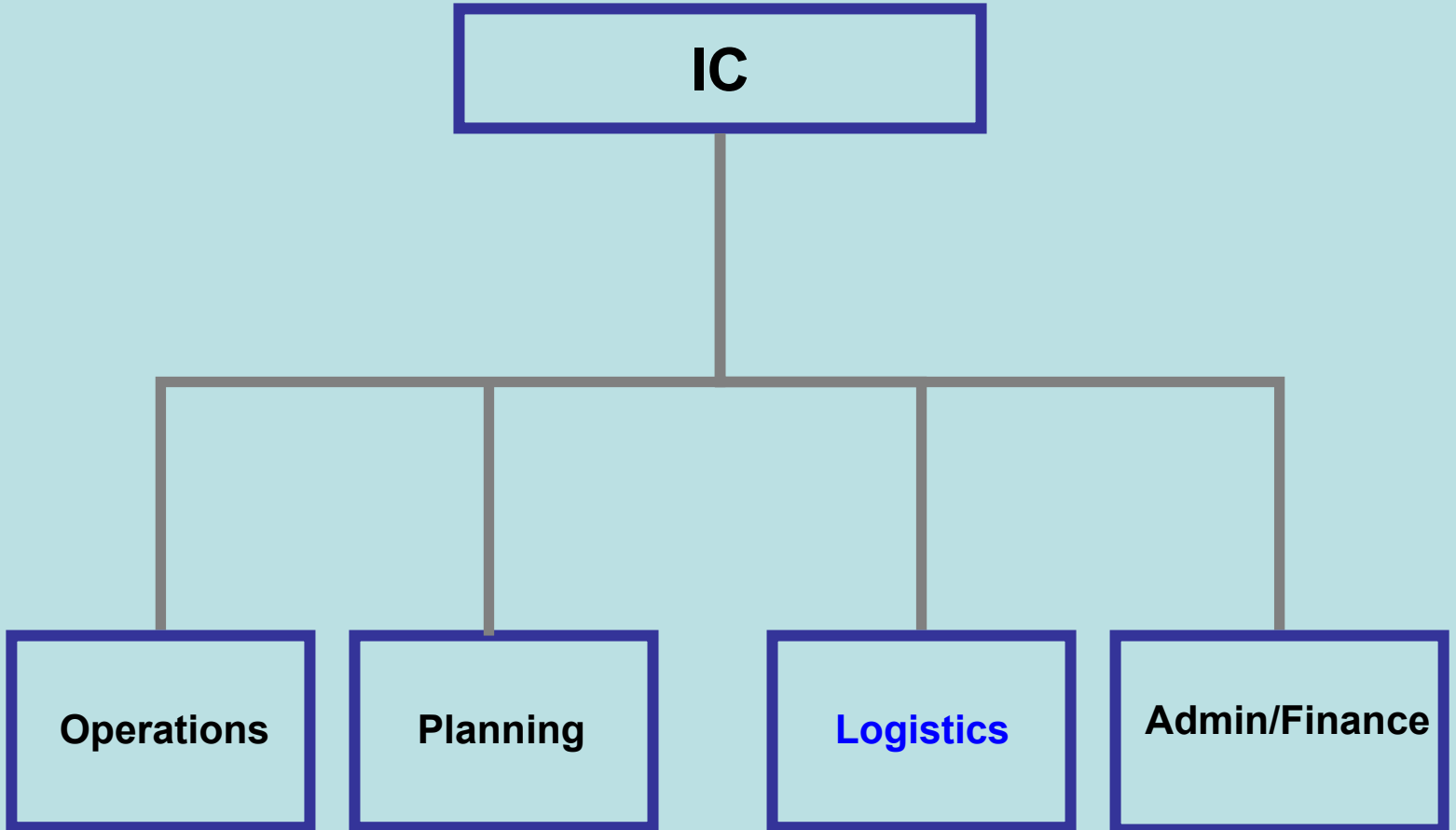

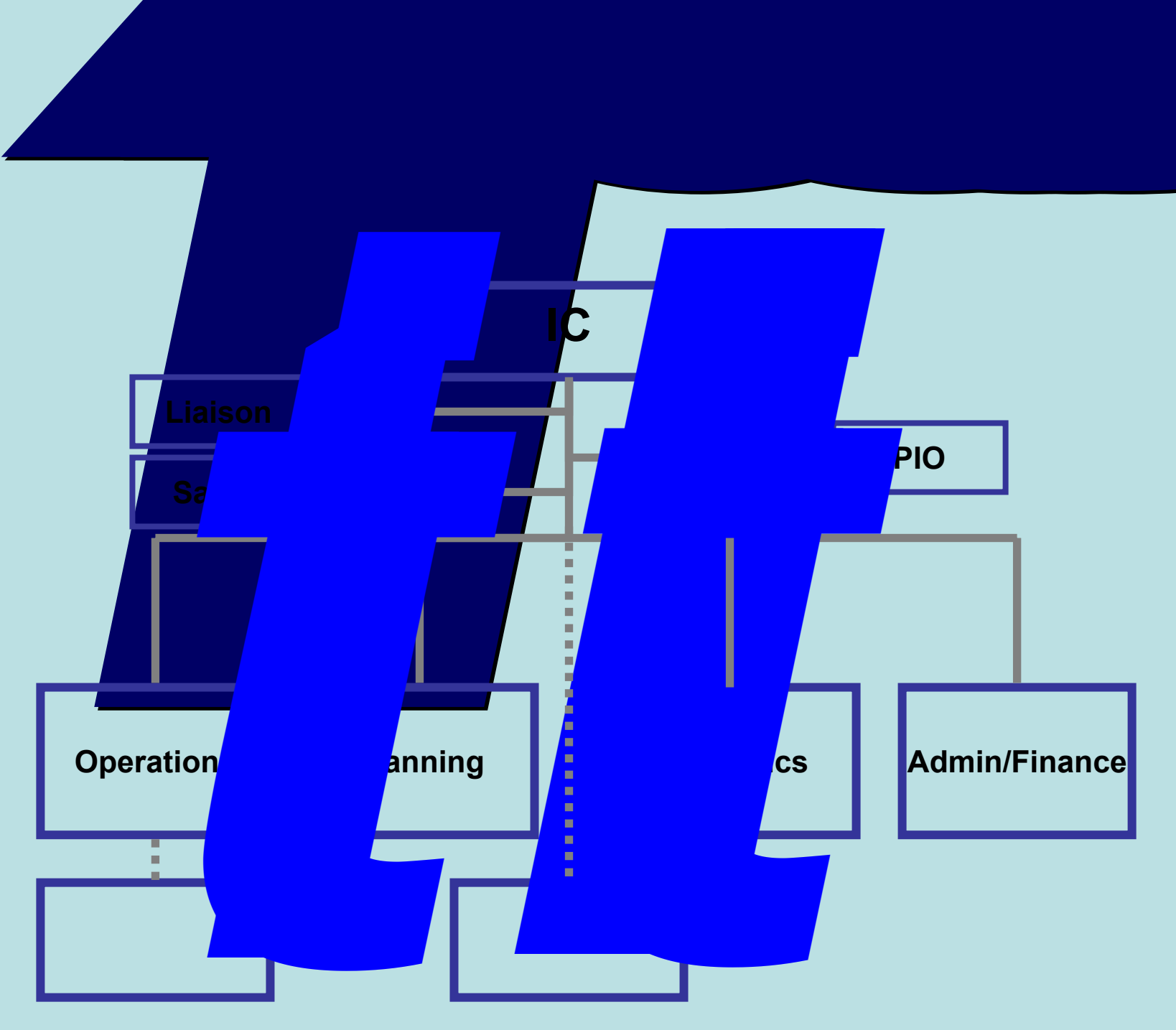




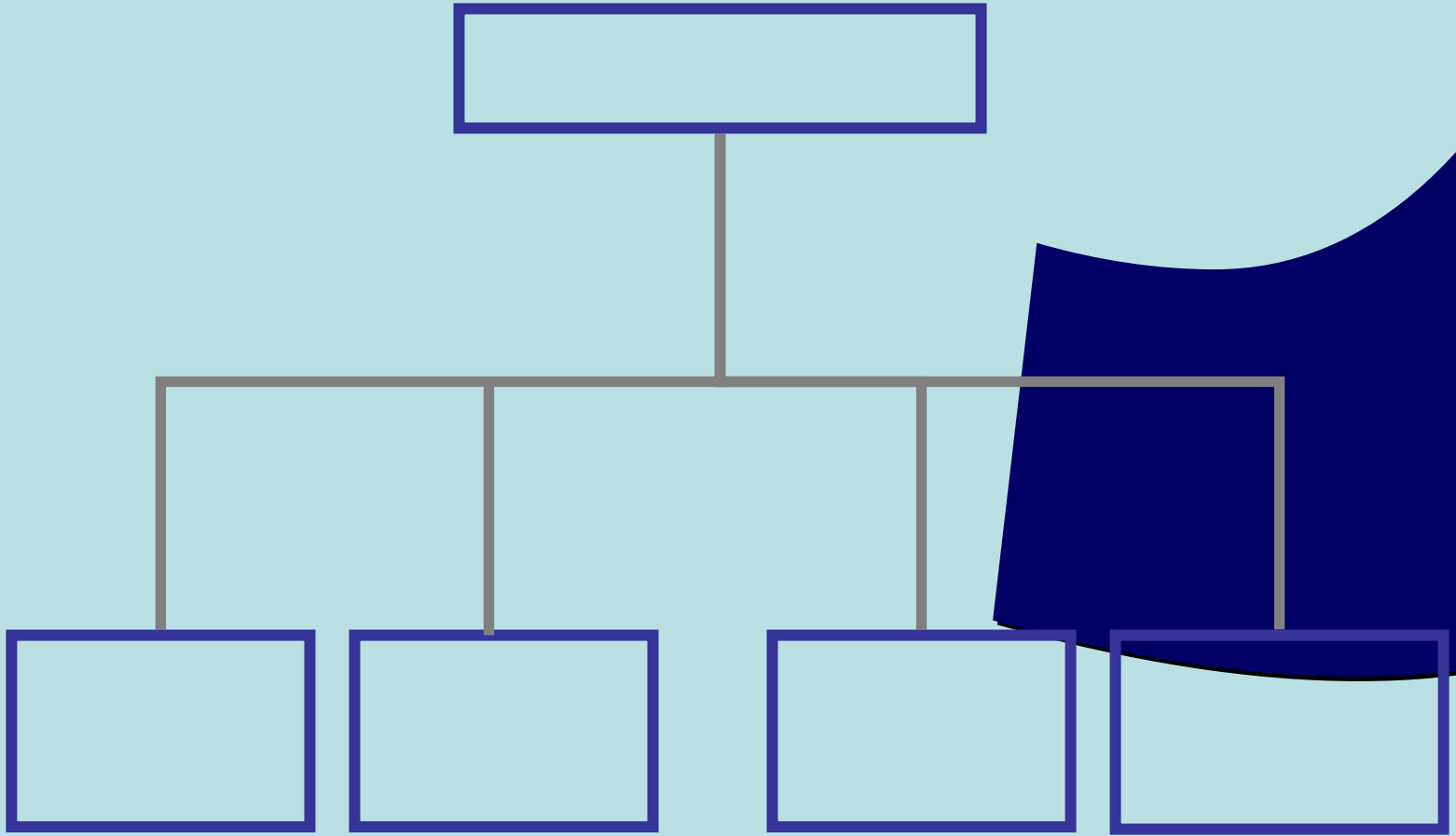


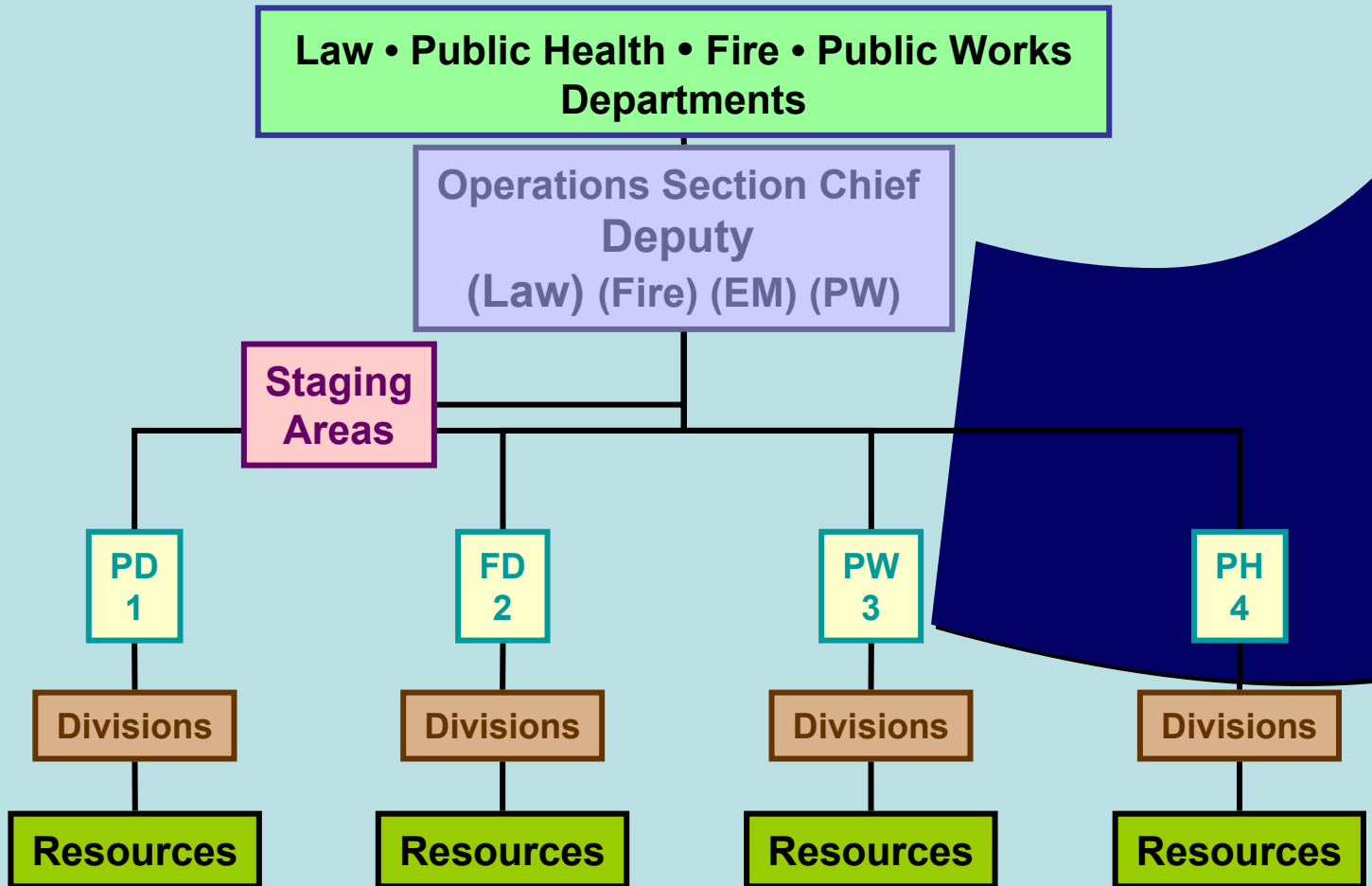












(Single/Teams/Task Forces)

- Single set of objectives
- Collective approach
- Single incident action plan
- Optimizes response effort

- Information flow and coordination
- Joint priorities and restrictions
- No legal authorities compromised

- EOC is coordination vs. operations

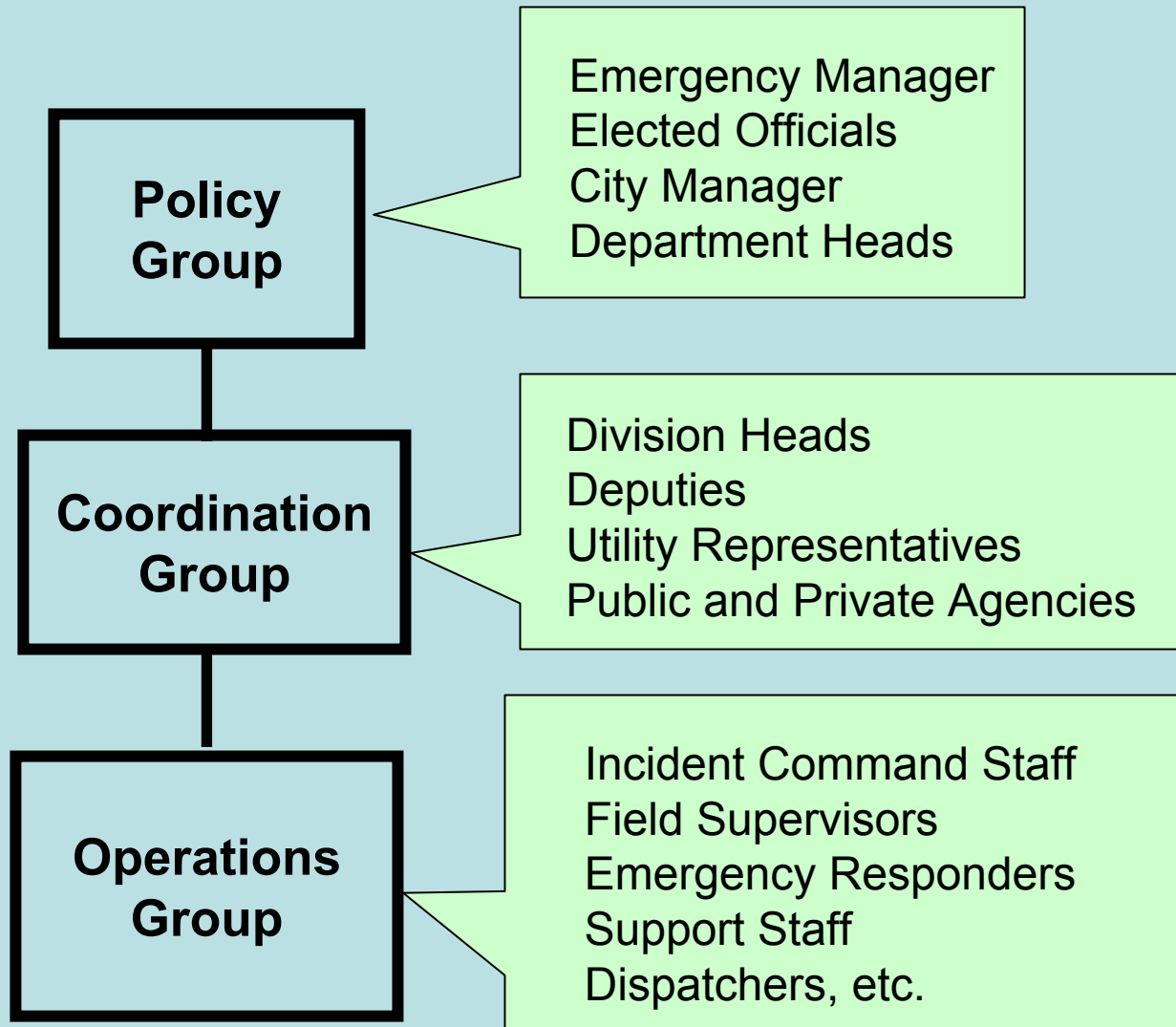

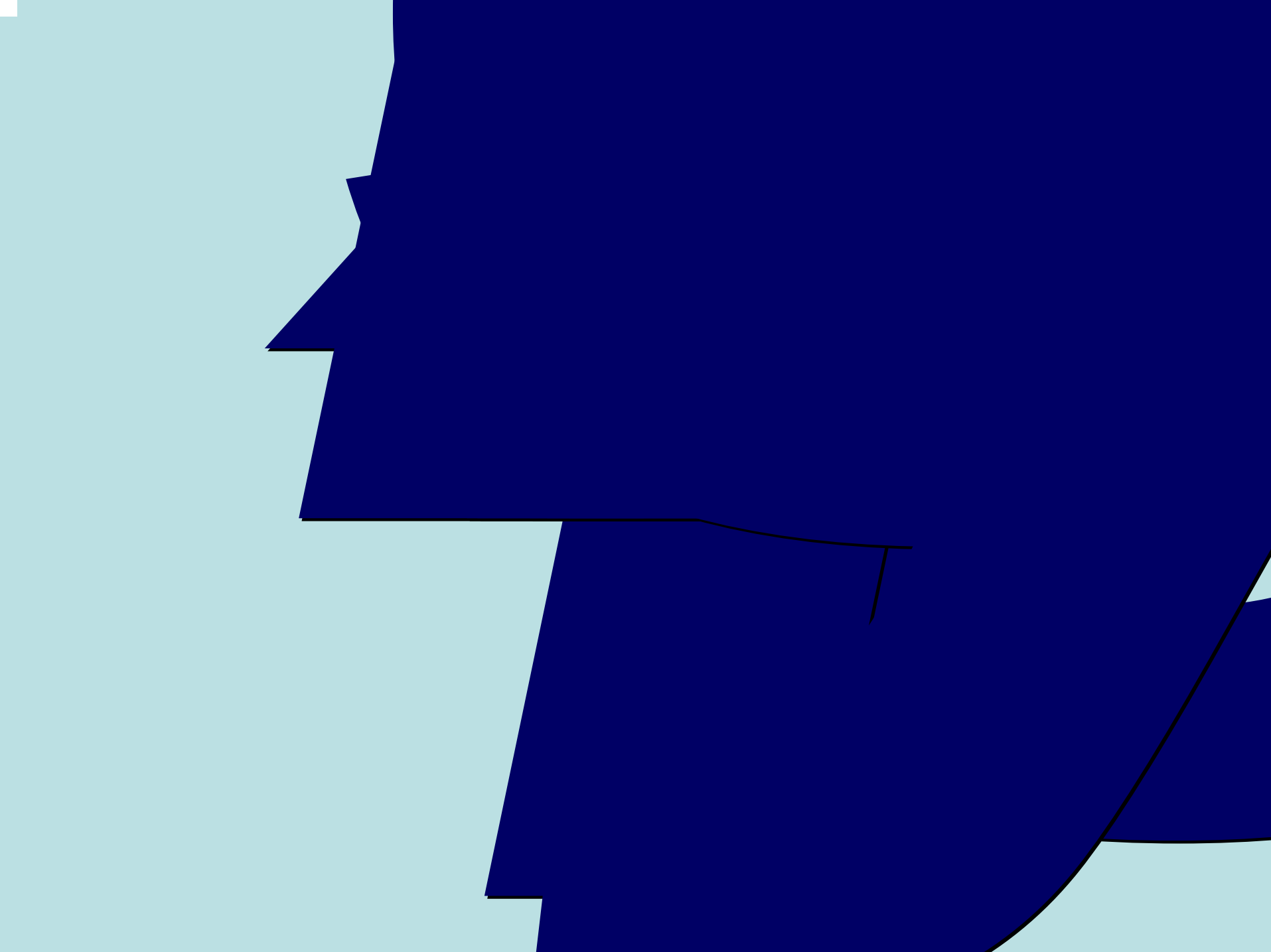
